Hybrid Chinese Cabbage

Green Rocket

DESCRIPTION: Very tall, with bright green crisp leaves, head weight approximately 4.5 lbs, cylindrical Michihili type

MATURITY: Early, approximately 70 days after sowing

CULTURAL CHARACTERISTICS: This variety has moderate tolerance to heat and cold. Green Rocket has a notably long shelf life. Recommended for fall to winter harvest.

FEATURES

- Long shelf-life
- Crisp leaves

BENEFITS

- Good shipping quality
- Desirable market characteristics

Note: Chinese Cabbage is prone to vernalization. Bud differentiation and bolting results from low temperatures of 40°F (5°C) for a week or 50°F (10°C) for two weeks. For spring harvest, transplant seedlings with 5-7 true leaves raised at 74–75°F (23-24°C) during the day and over 54°F (12°C) at night. Providing plants with adequate water and fertilizer after transplanting will promote faster growth.
